Home Maintenance Worker **Community Support Services** **Full-time Permanent Position**

Overview: The Home Maintenance Worker will provide home maintenance support to the elderly and people living in the community with disabilities who are clients of the Community Support Services Program. The purpose of this position is to assist clients in need with their activities of daily living enabling clients to remain independent longer in their home and community.

Qualifications:

1. Previous work experience with providing services for the aged and/or disabled.
2. Experience and knowledge in home repair and maintenance activities (painting, cleaning, carpentry, etc.).
3. Must be able and familiar in the operation and maintenance of electrical/gas hand tools, saws, lawnmowers, snowmobiles, etc.
