## ANY MATTER A RESIDENT WISHES TO RAISE

Aaron Nelles was in attendance to address Chief and Council to request funds for a fire fighting training costs. Aaron was also suggesting amalgamating the TFN Fire Fighting volunteers with the other TFN emergency services so that everything is under one umbrella.

Gilbert Katt was in to address Chief and Council on a few matters as follows:

- a) Gilbert requested having access to the September TAA/TFN Joint Assembly. Gilbert was informed that he could view the video by setting up a time with Courtney to view the recording.
- b) Gilbert raised concern with his impression that TFN should have done more to get our most experienced Water Plant Operator to stay and work for TFN. It was pointed out to Gilbert that TFN could not compete with what his new employer had offered this Plant Operator. Gilbert also requested to have a discussion regarding the TFN Personnel Policy added to the agenda for the next Community Meeting.

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- c) Gilbert express concern that there seems to be a lack of information of what is happening with the Land Settlement Negotiations. Gilbert requested that Land Settlement Negotiations also be added to the agenda for the next Community Meeting.
  - \*Second Chief John Turner recommended that minutes from the TAA/TFN Joint Council meetings be posted to the TFN website. Noted for the record.
  - d) Gilbert said he was concerned that Councillor Doug McKenzie was bullying people at the September 20<sup>th</sup>/19 TAA/TFN Joint Assembly and again the Community Information Session on March 10<sup>th</sup>/20. TFN Council members responded to Gilbert stating that they did not feel that Councillor McKenzie was bullying people at either of these forums.
  - e) Lastly, Gilbert expressed concern about the relationship between the TAA and TFN Councils and the problems that can happen with two Councils not getting along. TFN Council members informed Gilbert that there has been quorums for the last three or four TAA/TFN Joint Council meetings and differing opinions are shared sometimes, but they are all trying to work together. Council also let Gilbert know that there will be a Community update on Land Settlement Negotiations, as well as an introduction to the Director of Negotiations and Lawyer.

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### **EMERGENCY HEALTH UPDATE – HEALTH SERVICES MANAGER**

Wayne referred Council to TFN's Emergency Preparedness Plan in the section that covers a Pandemic protocol. The protocol in this plan identifies who is responsible for what. Wayne went on to say that although the World Health Organization has declared a pandemic, TFN is following the Ontario government's lead as it relates to the spread of COVID 19 and our area is still considered low risk.

Wayne informed Council that he would be attending a meeting between PEOC/Temagami Health Unit/and other health organizations on the morning of Monday, March 16/20.

Virginia stated that the community and TFN membership will be kept informed of matters around this virus through the TFN website and communiques circulated in the community.

#### Matters noted for the record:

- LMLC and TMFC is closed until April 06/20
- Currently, there are no known cases of COVID 19 in the community of Bear Island
- All TFN non-essential travel is now suspended
- TFN members at risk should not travel
- All gatherings/meetings are postponed until further notice activities on the land are encouraged
- Anyone who has travelled internationally, should consider self isolating upon returning from travel
