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**ANNUAL WORK SCHEDULE FOR THE TIMISKAMING FOREST**  
**April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 to March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023**

**3.1 Introduction**

The annual work schedule (AWS) for the Timiskaming Forest outlines the scheduling of previously approved forest management activities identified in the 2021 – 2031 Timiskaming Forest Management Plan (FMP). This AWS year represents the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the 10-year FMP. The conditions on regular operations identified and approved in the forest management plan will be followed in the implementation of this annual work schedule.

**3.2.4 Fire Prevention and Preparedness**

Conditions and procedures on forest fire prevention and preparedness measures to be implemented during the annual fire season are described in Module 16 of the Implementation Toolkit, found in Section 6.1.16 of the Supplementary Documentation. The Modifying Industrial Operations Protocol (MIOP) has information on fire legislation and states minimum required equipment for a fire cache – a working pump and three shovels required. An itemized list of the minimum fire suppression equipment is also available in Appendix A in MIOP. The Primary List of Emergency Contacts and NDMNRF Fire Reporting Organization Chart are located in Appendix 1 and 2 of this AWS. An itemized list of shareholder/contractor owned fire suppression equipment available for rent will be provided to the NDMNRF Fire Management Supervisor, Timmins Fire Management Headquarters, South Porcupine as a separate submission prior to April 1<sup>st</sup> to retain confidentiality.

**3.2.5 Monitoring and Assessment**

**Annual Component of the Compliance Plan**

The annual component of the 10-year compliance strategy will be developed in more detail as part of annual compliance planning and will be communicated as part of the information exchange between SFL, NDMNRF and forest operators prior to AWS implementation.

The Forest Compliance Handbook recognizes that the compliance program embraces risk management, streamlines compliance planning activities and reduces redundancy with other existing government reporting requirements and external third-party standards. The primary focus of the annual compliance program will be inspecting and reporting on forest management activities with attention to the elimination of redundant processes. The program will focus on inspecting a sample of operations to ensure compliance with the forest management plan. Simple checklists have been provided for TFAI inspectors to record where operations are in compliance, with options for more detail and follow-up in those situations where an operational issue has been identified.

***Timing and Frequency***

The SFL holder and shareholder contractors will conduct Forest Operations Inspections on all operations in accordance with the ten-year compliance strategy in the Forest Management Plan.

3 Refer to the Compliance Schedule in Appendix 3.

5                   ***Compliance Performance Review***

6  
7 The SFL has seen a decrease in the number of remedial outcomes arising from operational issues  
8 when assessed from the start of the FMP. 1 remedial outcome was recorded in 2019-20 to date  
9 with a second pending and performance overall can be considered good. The few recurring  
10 compliance challenges have been identified as installation of water crossings and work within the  
11 crossing AOC and Change to Operations involving stream AOC's. Communication of standards  
12 and additional operator training will continue through the year i.e. Spring Operator Meeting. A  
13 joint session of NDMNRF and Industry inspectors will be held in the fall of the upcoming AWS  
14 year, as it provides an opportunity to communicate and improve the overall compliance program.

15  
16                   ***Notification of Status of an Operation***

17  
18 A status report of forest operations will be prepared and used by TFAI to document operations.  
19 A web-based notification system will be used once again this operating year. Notices will be  
20 available to download by applicable NDMNRF staff, which is designed to meet the requirements  
21 to notify. In those cases where operations have been suspended from the previous year and  
22 carried forward to the current operating season, notification details can also be downloaded. A  
23 status report of forest operations correspondence will be sent to applicable NDMNRF district leads  
24 on a weekly basis.

25  
26                   ***Monitoring Compliance of Forest Operations***

27  
28 No change is anticipated to the monitoring program for the upcoming operating season and  
29 reporting will remain consistent with the ten-year compliance strategy in the Forest Management  
30 Plan.

31  
32                   ***Roles and Responsibilities***

33  
34 No change is anticipated to the organizational distribution of responsibilities for the upcoming  
35 operating season and implementation will remain consistent with the ten-year compliance  
36 strategy in the Forest Management Plan.

37  
38                   ***Compliance Reporting Areas***

39  
40 Compliance Reporting Areas (CRA) for harvest operations and advanced operational road  
41 construction will be identified consistent with the harvest block numbers as identified on Areas  
42 Selected for Operations Maps available on the Timiskaming Forest Alliance Inc. website and listed  
43 in the Compliance Schedule available in Appendix 3. CRAs for primary and branch road  
44 construction will be identified by road name, while CRAs for renewal and maintenance will be  
45 listed by activity as shown in Appendix 3 of this AWS text.

46  
47 Monitoring of Exceptions

1 There is no monitoring of exceptions to be undertaken during the implementation of this AWS.

## 2 Regeneration Assessment

3  
4  
5 Areas have been selected for regeneration assessment based on the year of regeneration  
6 treatment and the age for assessment as identified in table FMP-20. Approximately 7,000 hectares  
7 have been scheduled for aerial and ground assessment during this AWS period. This will be  
8 submitted as an AWS Changes layer before June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.

## 9 Roads

10  
11  
12 Roads and water crossings will be monitored during this AWS. The method and frequency of  
13 monitoring to be followed is outlined in the "Roads and Water Crossing Monitoring Program" (see  
14 Implementation Toolkit Module 6 – SuppDoc 6.1.16).

### 15 **3.3 Road Strategies**

16  
17  
18 During the 2022-2023 operating year, any road constructed in Moose Emphasis Areas (MEAs) will  
19 follow the conditions and guidelines as per the FMP Supp Doc, Section 6.1.17, Part 8: Road  
20 Strategies, as follows:

21  
22 With a focus on the intent rather than the means, the following guiding principles should be used:

- 23  
24 1. Reduce the number of MEA's on the landbase by identifying and eliminating 1 or 2 less  
25 desirable MEA's in order to achieve the target 10-15% of the productive landbase.
- 26  
27 2. Evaluate opportunities for the use of portable bridges over the installation of large culverts  
28 (i.e. > 6 feet in diameter) (in specific pinch points). This strategy would be applied mostly  
29 to a Branch Road.
- 30  
31 3. Take advantage of synergies with regards to the road transfer protocol and remove  
32 crossings in MEA's on roads where its anticipated that the SFL intends to transfer  
33 responsibility to MNRF (as per the current MNRF Road Transfer protocol)
- 34  
35 4. During plan implementation, the location of operational roads will be selected to minimize  
36 the likelihood of creating long-term access (e.g. winter harvest, natural geographical  
37 features, water-crossing)
- 38  
39 5. Where there is no other options or alternatives, and as a last recourse: the planning team  
40 will pre-identify a requirement for decommissioning an operational area within the MEA  
41 and the exact location will be left to the SFL to select and complete during plan  
42 implementation. Conditions and methods are included in the implementation toolkit of the  
43 FMP.

44  
45 Each MEA was reviewed considering the Stand and Site Guide and Steering Committee direction.  
46 The resulting strategies are presented in FMP-18, which assigns branch roads and ORBs within  
47 MEAs with general decommissioning direction, rather than a site specific plan. This enables a  
48 focus on the intent (i.e. reduce access to a given operational sector within an MEA) while

1 remaining flexible for how and where the decommissioning efforts are completed. The following  
2 conditions are listed, where applicable, in FMP-18 for specific branch roads and ORBs within MEAs:  
3

- 4 1. A portable bridge will be installed and removed on at least one watercrossing, where this  
5 structure is suitable for the watercourse. In addition, it was agreed that access  
6 management will be implemented within 2 years of harvest operations being completed  
7 in associated harvest blocks scheduled for natural regeneration, or within 5 years of  
8 harvest operations being completed which are scheduled for artificial regeneration.  
9
- 10 2. Efforts will be made to make the road inaccessible to 4x4 trucks using the most practical  
11 and cost-effective method(s) available. The methods may include winter road construction  
12 and/or decommissioning methods such as ditching, berming, slash piling and water  
13 crossing removal. This only applies to new roads constructed in the 2021 FMP. The  
14 decommissioning methods will be applied at or near the intersections of branch, primary  
15 and existing roads, to ensure the objective of no net increase of new roads within MEA's,  
16 is met. Decommissioning methods that prove to be ineffective will be improved upon  
17 based on discussions with the NDMNRF.  
18
- 19 3. Access management will be implemented within 2 years of harvest operations being  
20 completed in associated harvest blocks scheduled for natural regeneration, or within 5  
21 years of harvest operations being completed which are scheduled for artificial  
22 regeneration.  
23

### 24 **3.4 Marketability Strategy**

25  
26 The 2022-2023 Annual Work Schedule on the Timiskaming Forest will follow the current *Northeast*  
27 *Region Creating Forest Operations Opportunities in Low Market Conditions Strategy* as outlined  
28 in Module 18: Licensing and Wood Measurement of the Implementation Toolkit.
