TFN Enrichment Funds Aftercare Policy Effective November 1, 2022

1. PURPOSE:

1.1 To set out guidelines for the administration of the Aftercare program.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1 Registered Members of the Temagami First Nation
- 2.2 Upon exhausting benefits through local Community Care Access Centre or Home & Community Care programs.

3. ALLOCATION:

- 3.1 Eligible TFN members can access up to a maximum of \$500.00 to assist with expenses
- 3.2 The fiscal year is from April 1st each year to March 31st of the next year.
- 3.3 Funding is approved on a first come first served basis, according to the date received by the Office Manager until the annual set funding has been expended.
- 3.4 Expenses incurred before funding is approved will only be reimbursed if the expenses are eligible and there are funds remaining/available in the budget.

4. PROCESS FOR REQUESTING FUNDS:

- 4.1 Temagami First Nation member must submit a letter and necessary documentation from Physician or specialist outlining request and associated costs to the Doreen Potts Health Centre - Office Manager. Applicants can only apply on behalf of themselves
- 4.2 Requests will then be forwarded to the Finance Department for payment
- 4.3 All ORGINIAL receipts must be submitted before payments are issued to the Doreen Potts Health Centre – Office Manager for service rendered.

5. AFTERCARE COVERAGE & FIXED RATES:

5.1 Transportation \$0.42 cents/km

5.2 Companion and/or care-sitters \$35.00/day and/or \$20.00/night

5.3 Family respite services \$35.00/day and/or \$20.00/night

5.4 Homemaking services: Meal preparation, cleaning, shopping & laundry (\$15/hour)

\$25.00/day or \$50.00/day for 2 or more 5.5 Infant & childcare

chronic care co-payments (one-time) 5.6 Alternate Level of Care
