

# **TFN Enrichment Funds Computer for Students Policy Effective November 1, 2022**

#### 1. PURPOSE:

1.1 The purpose for this policy is to set out guidelines for the administration of the computer for students' program.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1 Registered Members of the Temagami First Nation who are not in financial arrears with the Temagami First Nation are eligible; who are Full Time Secondary (Grades 9-12), Post-Secondary or Graduate students.
- 2.2 Students who have less than 3 months left in their program are not eligible.
- 2.3 Students may apply every 3 years.

### 3. ALLOCATION:

- Eligible TFN students can access a maximum of \$800.00 to assist with the purchase of a computer/laptop only
- 3.2 Funding is approved on a first come first served basis, according to the date received by the Enrichment Clerk until the annual set funding has been expended.
- 3.3 Expenses incurred before application is approved will only be reimbursed if the member/purchase is eligible and there are funds available in the budget.
- Costs over the amount of the subsidy will need to be covered by the student or his/her parent or guardian.
- 3.5 Students are responsible for all maintenance, upgrades, and repairs to computers/laptops and/or software purchased.

# 4. APPLICATION PROCESS:

- Submit a completed application form that identifies the computer/laptop and software (i.e. such as operating program, word processing, etc.) that is required to meet the students' needs;
- 4.2 Submit a written estimate of the computer/laptop and/or software being requested.
- 4.3 The written estimate must be from a licensed retailer unless obtained online.
- The estimate must include the computer/laptop costs and licensed software that is identified as a requirement on the application form.
- 4.5 Show proof of full-time schooling ex. Timetable, acceptance letter, etc.

4.5 Note: All applicants (or parent or guardian) will be required to complete an agreement form once approved.

### 5 PROCESS FOR RECEIVING FUNDS:

5.1 Students must sign and return the Computer Agreement before funds are released.

# 6 COMPLETION OF PROJECT / AGREEMENT:

6.1 The project will be deemed complete when the terms and conditions of the agreement have been fulfilled and completed.

#### 7 Items that are not covered:

- 7.1 Printer
- 7.2 Tablets
- 7.3 Computer mouse, mouse pads, USBs, etc.
