FORESTRY CREW MEMBER POSITION

As part of its Forestry Initiative, Daki Menan Lands and Resources Corporation (DMLRC) is recruiting forestry crew members for contract positions. This is a seasonal position.

Job Description:

Crew Members will assist the Crew Boss/General Manager with the following tasks:

- Assist in the completion of forestry projects (e.g. tree planting and thinning).
- Utilize GPS software (Avenza) to provide mapping.
- Work with DMLRC staff in completing project proposals (e.g. 2 Billion Trees Initiative).
- Work alongside the crew in tree planting, thinning, sawmill and firewood operations.
- Will be expected to work outdoors.

Successful applicants are expected to:

- Arrive to work in a timely manner.
- Maintain good hygiene (shower, deodorant, brush teeth, etc.).
- Always follow all Safety Procedures and Policies.
- Complete assigned tasks in a safe, effective, and timely manner.
- Adhere to all COVID-19 safety protocols if required.
