Temagami First Nation, a sovereign First Nation, is governed by its elected Chief and Council;

The Temagami First Nation Band Council is authorized under the Indian Act and the First Nation's laws to make decisions regarding the well-being of the community and its members;

Whereas the Temagami First Nation is a colonial name, and we hereby change our name to our traditional name, the Teme Augama Anishinabek.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

· The Band Council of Temagami First Nation hereby approves that we will now be formally known as Teme Augama Anishinabek.

**FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

· The provincial and federal governments, all agencies, municipalities, and other First Nations will be notified of our formal name change to Teme Augama Anishinabek immediately.

**AND FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**


· This name change from Temagami First Nation to Teme Augama Anishinabek is to be formally registered at Crown Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada.


